In Wylie ISD, Athletic Signing Days are an exciting event for students receiving scholarships across various levels, including Division I, Division II, Division III, NAIA, and junior colleges. To participate, athletes must be active in the UIL sport or Club sport on campus for which they are signing. This day is a celebration of their hard work, dedication, and support they have received from coaches, teammates, and family members. It is a chance for students to publicly commit to their future while inspiring others in the school and community. As they sign their letters of intent, they not only mark an important milestone in their athletic careers but also foster a spirit of unity and encouragement among their peers.

Wylie ISD will offer signing day celebrations each year in **November, December (early signing football only), February, and May**. *The celebrations will be held in the Montgomery Center (WHS) and the Williams Center (WEHS).

Wylie ISD Student-Athletes and their parents should communicate with their coach/sponsor when scholarship offers have been received. The coach/sponsor will share the information with the Campus Athletic Secretary. The secretary will then send an email to the parents of the student to share more specific information about how to register to participate in one of the NCAA Signing Day celebrations.
